LEARN WITH CREATIVE CONFIDENCE (LwCC) is a K-6 asset-based SEL curriculum that fosters creative confidence and resilience in students and educators. LwCC promotes a positive school climate by engaging the entire school community. The curriculum is based on **The 10 Principles** of Creativity, which were developed by the organization's founders, teacher Marina Krim and her husband Kevin, after the tragic loss of two of their children.




HOW LWCC WORKS


LwCC establishes an understanding of the 10 Principles by grade level through **flexible**, **inquiry-based lessons**. **The Principles and SEL skills are also embedded into the National Process Standards** so that teachers can make explicit connections to their students' creativity during instruction.

The curriculum also consists of Principle-specific book lists with discussion questions, hands-on STEAM activities, family engagement newsletters, creative confidence-building exercises for staff, and colorful visuals for the classroom.

WHAT NEED DO WE FILL?

LwCC is grounded in the belief ecology, or intrapersonal skills, which is overlooked in many traditional SEL programs. A belief ecology ultimately influences one's ability and desire to deploy the skills within the values, perspectives, and identity domains. Traditional Tier I programs such as Second Step or Sanford Harmony target the cognitive, emotional, and social domains of SEL, or interpersonal skills. LwCC's emphasis on building students' belief ecology can lead to improved self-efficacy, openness, and encourage a growth mindset.

HOW DO WE MEASURE SUCCESS?

We measure students' understanding through assessment methods advised by the Harvard Graduate School of Education's EASEL Lab. The program aligns with existing SEL screening tools (e.g. Panorama, DESSA), offers formative checks throughout, and uses student and teacher surveys to gain valuable insight.

HOW MUCH DOES LWCC COST?

LwCC will provide professional development workshops for all school staff and access to all LwCC materials for \$2,000 per school year. This is a great opportunity for your school to use available ESSER funds to help address learning loss.
